

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF CINCINNATI GUIDED CITY TOUR**

This five hour professionally guided tour begins from the heart of our city, Fountain Square where many people gather for their brown bag lunches, concerts, sports and political rallies. We will pass the Contemporary Arts Center, Procter & Gamble International Headquarters and the Taft Museum, located in beautiful Lytle Park. You will become familiar with many of Cincinnati's most well-known landmarks including the Museum Center at Union Terminal, Music Hall, Bicentennial Commons, Paul Brown Stadium and Great American Ball Park (GABP) – the home of the Cincinnati Bengals and the Cincinnati Reds. We will make a stop at the American Sign Museum, where you will see some a collection of some very famous signs such as Coca Cola, Howard Johnson's Ice Cream, Zenith Radio & TV and many more.

Cincinnati has a very German Catholic Heritage, we will make a stop at the famous Hofbrau Haus for lunch.

Climb some of Cincinnati's famous 7 hills and take in spectacular views. We will enjoy the old world charm of Mount Adams, with its 'shot-gun' row of homes and charming district of shops and restaurants. Picturesque Eden Park is the home of the Cincinnati Art Museum and the Playhouse in the Park professional Theater, and Krohn Conservatory.

We will cross the Ohio River into Kentucky's historic Riverside Drive with its antebellum homes. We'll pass the entertainment district at 'Newport on the Levee' and the World Peace Bell – the largest free-swinging bell in the world. While in Kentucky, we will enjoy a different breathtaking view of the Cincinnati skyline. You might even be able to see Cincinnati's 7 hills and the very lush green area that surrounds such a beautiful city.

## Optional Tour Descriptions

### 1) **Highlights of Cincinnati & Kentucky Guided Bus Tour (professional guide)**

This 5 hour guided tour takes in the sites of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky. Sites include a stop at the American Sign Museum. Then we will see the sites of the Contemporary Arts Center, Procter & Gamble Int'l Headquarters, the Taft Museum Lytle Park. You will also visit Mirror Lake inside the famous Eden Park and the Old World Charm of Mt. Adams and the Cincinnati Art Museum and Krohn Conservatory. Included in this tour is lunch at the Hofbrau Haus. Next we'll be on our way to Northern Kentucky to the historic Riverside Drive, Newport on the Levee and the world famous Peace Bell—the largest free-swinging bell in the world. And you'll find that both Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky have beautiful architecture.

### 2) **Queen City Underground Walking Tour**

Join us to learn about Cincinnati's hidden history on one of the Top Five Underground Tours in the U.S.\* Enjoy a stroll through Over-the-Rhine, home to America's largest set of historical landmarks. Visit buildings in the Gateway District that were home to over 130 saloons, bars, beer gardens, and theaters that hosted iconic entertainers like Buffalo Bill Cody. Then, descend below the city streets to a hidden crypt where some of Cincinnati's first residents were buried. Next return underground to explore newly discovered tunnels vital to Cincinnati's brewery heritage. Finally end the tour with a visit to the Christian Moerlein bottling plant and tap room.

### 3) **Private Lager Walking Tour**

This 1-1/2 walking tour explores the 'heart of Cincinnati's Brewery District. The tour starts at the World famous Findlay Market (2-1/2 blocks from our hotel) and lets you experience the pre-Prohibition Christian Morlein Brewery, complex that was once the largest in the country. The tour continues to the Sohn/Cliffside Brew House, where you'll experience some stellar examples of brewery architecture in Cincinnati. The final stop is deep under the Jackson Brewery, where you'll venture through the massive network of lagering cellars in the Clifton hillside. (PLEASE NOTE: This is a walking tour through the former breweries, and involves walking about 8 blocks outside and through the old buildings, so please wear comfortable shoes and dress accordingly).
