CACI Eastern Regional Convention Historic Leesburg, Loudoun County, Virginia May 5-7, 2017

The Spring Eastern Regional will be held in Leesburg, Virginia, and nearby - an area rich in history. See http://www.leesburgva.gov/visitors/history-of-leesburg for a good overview.

Historic Downtown Leesburg - Stroll the brick sidewalks of Leesburg's downtown and you'll find an amazing collection of well-preserved historic buildings, housing charming unique shops and restaurants. On May 5, first Friday of the month, the downtown area will be open late.

Marshall House - George Marshall organized the allied victory in WWII, and received the Nobel Peace Prize.

Morven Park - This 1,000 acre property features the historic home of Virginia Governor Westmoreland Davis, the Winmill Carriage Museum, the Museum of Hounds and Hunting, beautiful grounds and gardens and an equestrian center featuring the Commonwealth Dressage Competition on May 6 and 7.

Oatlands Historic House and Garden - A National Trust Historic Site, this stately mansion was the home of the Carter and Eustis families

Ball's Bluff Battlefield and National Cemetery - Located within the Ball's Bluff Battlefield Regional Park, trails and interpretive signs commemorate the Battle of Ball's Bluff, the first Civil War engagement to take place in Loudoun County. From April to November, the park offers free guided tours of the battlefield every Saturday and Sunday.

Nearby:

Mt. Zion Historic Park & Old School Baptist Church - Built in 1851, the church served various purposes during the Civil War, including a rendezvous point for Mosby's Rangers, a hospital and prison, and a battleground. The adjacent cemetery contains more than 240 marked headstones, and a War of 1812 veteran.

Oak Hill – President James Monroe house, a National Historic Landmark. It is privately owned, not generally open to the public, but we expect to have a tour here.

Aldie Mill Historic Park – Explore a 200 year old grist mill - President Monroe had his grain ground here; the park also played a role in civil war history.

Middleburg, Virginia – the nation's horse and hunt capital; the Middleburg Historic District is on the National Register of Historic Places

Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center (Smithsonian Air and Space Museum Annex) - Located at Dulles International Airport 20 minutes east of Leesburg, the museum features the Space Shuttle and the Enola Gay (the aircraft that dropped the atomic bomb on Hiroshima) among other fascinating exhibits. iFly – Loudoun County's indoor skydiving – for those who want that adrenalin rush! https://www.iflyworld.com/loudoun/

Within an hour's drive:

Manassas National Battlefield Park – Located less than an hour south of Leesburg, the Manassas National Battlefield Park is the site of the first major battle of the Civil War. This battle, also known as the First Battle of Bull Run, made it clear to both sides of the conflict that the war was not going to be short and easily won by either side, but long and costly in both finances and lives.

Harpers Ferry National Historic Park – Located less than an hour north of Leesburg where the Shenandoah River meets the Potomac, this is the historic site of John Brown's Rebellion, an omen of the terrible war about to begin.

Washington, **DC** – and all the sites in DC.
