Yosemite, Kings Canyon, and Sequoia National Parks Adventure with Scenic Train Ride on the Sugar Pine Mountain Railroad July 18-21, 2026

Extend your vacation with an exciting train ride on the Sugar Pine Mountain Railroad. Then travel through scenic southern California to see Yosemite, Kings Canyon, and Sequoia National Parks. Heading back to Sacramento, see Fresno's Forestier Underground Gardens and the Castle Air Museum. We'll have lunch and dinners together, but the cost will be on your own, except as noted.

Day 1, Saturday July 18

We travel to Fish Camp, CA where we ride the Sugar Pine Mountain Railroad through scenic Sierra National Forest. Lunch is included. We attend Mass at Our Lady of the Sierra in Oakhurst and stop for dinner in Oakhurst. We will stay overnight at the Fairfield Inn, Oakhurst, CA,

Day 2, Sunday July 19

We travel to Yosemite Park Lodge where we stop for lunch on our own at Yosemite Lodge. We'll see nearby Yosemite falls, then meet with our Guide from the Yosemite Conservancy for their tour of the park. Dinner will be in Oakhurst. For overnight we'll return to the Fairfield Inn in Oakhurst.

Day 3, Monday July 20

We travel to Kings Canyon National Park and pick up our guide from the Sequoia conservancy. We'll see the General Grant Tree in Grants Grove, then head to Sequoia National Park and stop at the Giant Forest Museum. We'll have lunch at Beetle Rock followed by a guided tour of the park. Then on to Visalia for dinner and overnight at the Comfort Inn.

Day 4, Tuesday July 21

Heading back to Sacramento we visit the Forestiere Underground Gardens in Fresno. We'll lunch along the way to the Castle Air Museum in Atwater where we'll see their collection of airplanes. We will overnight at the Holiday Inn Express Airport in Sacramento. They have a complimentary shuttle.
